

Brentford Waterside Heritage Trail

We are currently seeking funds from LB Hounslow for the establishment of a Brentford Waterside Heritage Trail, which will run along the Thames Path from Kew Bridge to Brentford Bridge and at other locations in Brentford.

This project will see the installation of a series of interpretive boards which will provide information on Brentford's rich social and economic history. We know from our surveys that the waterside is the single most important "cultural cornerstone" for our community.

We have been working with LB Hounslow, the Canal and River Trust, the Friends of Watermans Park, private landowners, and the Brentford & Chiswick Local History Society.

We intend to submit a planning application in October 2021 and, if planning permission is granted, we hope that LB Hounslow will allocate funds for the project.
